#### MEDICAL OFFICER (OCCUPATIONAL MEDICINE)

The United States Coast Guard is seeking experienced licensed physicians to serve as Supervisory Medical Officers. Positions are available at the GS-14 through GS-15 level, with an annual salary ranging from \$102,721.00 - \$153,200.00. In addition, applicants may be eligible for Physician's Comparability Allowance (PCA) to a maximum of \$30,000. Relocation expenses will also be covered.

#### MAJOR DUTIES

- Performs and ensures the consistency and accuracy of medical fitness for duty evaluations conducted by medical evaluation personnel.
- Oversees the implementation of rules, regulations, guidance, and policy relative to the evaluation of merchant mariners.
- Plans and assigns work to medical evaluation staff.

#### KEY REQUIREMENTS

Before applying at USAjobs, you must have a Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Osteopathy degree and have had at least 1 year of supervised experience providing direct service in a clinical setting prior to obtaining the degree.

3 years of residency in the specialty of the position to be filled or equivalent experience and training is required. This may include family practice, internal medicine, surgery, pathology, dermatology, radiology, physical medicine and rehabilitation, public health, aerospace medicine, and general preventive medicine.

The Coast Guard offers excellent benefits including paid annual leave and sick leave, flexible work schedules, a Thrift Savings Plan (TSP), retirement and savings plans, health insurance, and on-site fitness center.
