#### COMPANY BACKGROUND

The Brooklyn Hospital Center (TBHC) is conducting a search for a Chair, Department of Radiology. The Brooklyn Hospital Center is a 464-bed **community teaching hospital** located in Downtown section of Brooklyn, New York. TBHC provides comprehensive health services, education and research to their communities and is a member of the **New York-Presbyterian Healthcare System (NYPHS)**.

TBHC serves approximately 1 million residents in the communities of central and north central Brooklyn. Much of the area surrounding TBHC is undergoing gentrification. Further more the hospital market of Brooklyn continues to be quite fluid with changes that create opportunities for further growth and development.

The *Department of Radiology* which includes Radiation Oncology services is fully equipped with modern imaging services, including Diagnostic Radiology, Nuclear Medicine, Ultrasound, SPECT/CT, MRI and Interventional Radiology all of which are integrated into Infinitt PACS system. In addition the department utilizes Nuance Voice Recognition System, Eclipsys RIS and Allscripts EMR.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

The Chair of Radiology will have an active clinical role in the Department and will provide strategic leadership, direction and coordination of all clinical endeavors for the Department of Radiology. The Chair will work collaboratively with medical and administrative leadership to accomplish the goals of the Department and the hospital. In addition, the Chair will work with institutional leadership to identify business development opportunities and facilitate the development of an outpatient market strategy for radiology. He/She will serve as the lead clinical spokesperson for the Department, enhances collaboration across divisions, implements and oversees quality initiatives.

*Specific functions and responsibilities of this position include the following:*

**Provide** vision and strategic direction for the creation and the development of a high quality, responsive and innovative professional radiology practice.

**Develop** a cutting edge professional radiology practice delivering the best in care and service for the community at large.

**Develop** a culture where excellence, quality and results are expected and rewarded appropriately.

**Direct** department-wide efforts to integrate clinical best practices, patient safety and service excellence.

**Establish** and conduct medical care evaluation and ongoing quality assurance and performance improvement.

**Responsible** for the development of policies and procedures outlining and governing the professional conduct of the Department of Radiology medical staff.

**Ensure** safe and federal regulatory compliance in the Department of Radiology; ensure that all credentialing requirements for the Department are met in a timely manner.

## **PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS**

The successful candidate will have achievements in clinical care and must have demonstrated management and leadership skills as well as vision for advancing the department's clinical standing. The ability to develop a culture of collaboration, innovation, and accountability is important. Candidates will have an appreciation of urban health issues, as well as an understanding of inner city populations and experience in urban healthcare.
